Waiver: <u>Snowbasin Waiver</u> is required for all competitors, coaches, and volunteers.

Lift Tickets: \$50.00/day (youth 7-12) and \$60/day (13+) includes tax. Tickets shall be purchased by

team captain at the Snowbasin Ticketing Yurt. Yurt opens at 7:30 am. Multi-day tickets available. Cash, Check or Credit Card accepted. Teams may also pre-purchase lift tickets (encouraged) by contacting ticketsales@snowbasin.com before race day. Please provide a copy of your Team Entry & Coaches List when purchasing tickets.

Little Cat lift will load early for easy return to the venue.

Coaches Tickets: Coaches MUST register through the USSS portal AND be included on entry form to

receive a lift ticket. Coaches MUST hold a current USSS Coach license/membership. Tickets for coaches can be picked up at Race HQ in the morning during bib collection.

Bibs: Bibs will be picked up by TC at Race HQ the morning of the Race. Athletes will turn the

bib in at the finish of the last race for the day. \$50 for all unreturned or damaged bibs.

Awards: Top 5 per gender U10, U12, U14+. Each day. 30 min after the protest period. Awards

will be in the Wildcat Parking lot.

Race HQ: New Race HQ in Earl's Lodge Huntington Room. Little Cat lift will be loading early to

facilitate getting to Wildcat lift for race inspection. The Wildcat Lot will have a roped

off area for teams to meet & pass out bibs/tickets.







Parking:
