**Bibs:** Team Captains pick up at the UOP each day  
 Athletes will turn in bibs at the finish each day. Lost or damaged bib \$50, payable to PCSS.

 Lift tickets can be purchased [HERE](#). Create an account and add athletes. **NO ONSITE PURCHASING of LIFT TICKETS.**  
 Team Captains do not need tickets but they **MUST** sign the UOP waiver [HERE](#).  
 They **MUST also be current with USSS** **by entry deadline.**
