Bibs: Team Captains pick up at the UOP each day

Athletes will turn in bibs at the finish each day. Lost or damaged bib \$50, payable to PCSS.

**Lift Tickets: \$ 20.00 /day** (plus tax).

Lift tickets can be purchased HERE. Create an account and add athletes. NO ONSITE PURCHASING of LIFT TICKETS.

Team Captains do not need tickets but they MUST sign the UOP waiver HERE.

They MUST also be current with USSS by entry deadline.

**Waiver**: <u>Utah Olympic Park Liability Release</u> is required for all competitors and coaches.

Note: for successful submission you must complete a brief email confirmation after filling out the form.

Parking: Parking is free at the base of the Hyeway Lift in the main museum parking lot.
