Events: 1 SL M/W & 1 GS M/W, no gender split. All teams will participate both days

Schedule: Saturday, March 7 SL M/W and Sunday, March 8 GS M/W

Eligible Racers: U8, U10, U12 per IMD handbook/eligibility.

Entry Fees: \$36.00/race (includes \$10.00 Souvenir Fee) - register and pay through <https://adminskiracing.com/>

Entry Deadline/Registration Permanently Closed: 03/04/2026 as of 11:59pm (MST)

Timeline: Feb 15 Registration Opens. Mar 2 at 5:00pm MST Late Fee in effect \$10/start . Mar 4 - 11:59pm MST Registration Permanently Closed.

Race HQ: Race HQ in Earl's Lodge Huntington Room 7:00-8:00. For the remainder of the day, Race HQ will be the finish shack at the bottom of Wildcat. Jury will meet and any protests shall be filed at Race HQ only.

Lift Tickets: \$50.00/day (youth 7-12) and \$60/day (13+) plus tax. Tickets shall be purchased by team captain at the Snowbasin Ticketing Yurt. Yurt opens at 7:00 am on race days. Multi-day tickets available. Cash, Check or Credit Card accepted. Teams may also pre-purchase lift tickets (encouraged) by emailing your athlete and Coach Team Entry to [_kbryan@snowbasin.com](mailto:kbryan@snowbasin.com) and calling 801.620.1043 to make payment before race day. Please provide a hard copy of your Team Entry & Coaches List when purchasing tickets in person at the yurt. Coaches Passes: Team Captains pick up & sign for each ticket at Race HQ each day. **Coaches must register through AdminSkiRacing and be current with USSS by entry deadline of March 4 - 11:59pm MST.** Little Cat lift will be loading early at 7:30 to facilitate getting from Race HQ to Wildcat lift for early load at 7:30am for race inspection. Please no foot traffic from Wildcat Lot K to Race HQ.



Bibs: Bibs will be picked up by TC at Race HQ each day. Athletes will turn in bibs at the finish each day. Lost or damaged bib \$50 payable to SSEF.
